



- 1. 65mm sand cement screed
- 2. Taped joint*
- 3. Min.500 gauge polythene
- 4. Regupol® high tack tape
- 5. Regupol® 6010SH 10mm or 15mm layer
- 6. Pre-cast or beam and block floor, minimum 300kg/m2
- 7. Acoustic cavity closer

- 8. Regupol® hi-tack tape or similar approved
- 9. Acoustic sealant
- 10. Regupol SH perimeter strip
- 11. Ceiling (construction type will vary)
- *DPM overlap to be minimum 100mm
